



In the two examples above, the white writing was done after bleach & photocopy. I used a spray bottle on the left and a brush on the right.

The Bleach on Black Trick

The Paper: Astrobrite Eclipse Black, both card and text weight are compatible in photocopiers. I'm sure other papers will work, just experiment.

The Copier: Photocopy with toner, not inkjet.

The Bleach: Major brand, full strength, freshly decanted. Don't let the bleach sit around in the spray bottle more than a day.

Do your writing as you normally do for a black & white photocopy (black ink on white paper).

Load the photocopier with the black paper. (Check with the counter folks about loading the paper in a drawer or hand-feeding it from the side.) Copy as you normally would onto the black paper.

Spray or brush the bleach over the areas you wish to reveal. Wait a few minutes for the lightening, and VIOLA!
