Calligraphy on Non-Traditional Surfaces – Carol DuBosch

- 1 Kitchen Alphabet: pointed brush script (WN Artisan Round #12), Golden Fluid Acrylic paint, chalk dots for guideline.
- 2 Rustics Scarf: Jacquard Textile Color acrylic fabric paint, WN Series 985 ¾" brush, chalk dots for guideline.
- 3 Rustics Shirt: (same as Rustics Scarf)
- 4 Starlight Nursery Wall: (same as Kitchen Alphabet)
- 5 Garden Board: Golden Fluid Acrylic paint, WN Series 985 ½" brush, transferred Monkey Bar Caps lettering design onto board using Saral.
- 6 Deck Board Casual Romans: Golden Fluid Acrylic paint, WN Series 985 ¾" brush
- 7 Rock Poem: Uniball Signo White Gel Pen for the Italic, 1/8" masking tape used as guidelines
- 8 Leaf: Fine point Sharpie Marker for the Italic
- 9 Italic Weeds Tile: 6" square glazed tile, Golden Fluid Acrylic paint (slightly diluted) to flow through a Kemper Tool or Ukrainian Egg Decorating Tool (Kistka). The writing tool is like a very small funnel, that will deliver thick media like acrylic paint.
- 10 Kindness Mug: The word was written in Italic with a Sakura Glaze Pen, allowed to dry for 24 hours, then baked at 325 degrees for 30 minutes. It is dishwasher safe now.
- 11 Terracotta Roof Tile: The copper Neuland was done with Pebeo Porcelaine paint using the nozzle. A Uniball White Gel Pen was used to the remaining text.
- 12 Winter Window: WN Series 985 ¾" brush and white poster paint on glass.
- 13 Curved Board: WN Series 985 $\frac{1}{2}$ " brush for the Neuland lettering, Golden Fluid Acrylic paint on painted board.
- 14 Neuland Alphabet Tile: WN Series 985 ½" brush, Golden Fluid Acrylic paint on a vintage slate tile.
- 15 Neuland Alphabet Napkin: WN Series 985 $\frac{1}{2}$ " brush, Jacquard Textile Color acrylic paint on a linen napkin.
- 16 Neuland Alphabet Barrel Board: WN Series 985 ½" brush, Golden Fluid Acrylic paint on a barrel board.






















